This Saturday afternoon part of the cast of the television series *Infames* appeared at a shopping mall in Mexico City, as part of the signing of autographs that they offered the public that supported them during their four months on the air, broadcast by Cadena Tres.

Although several days in advance we were told that Vanessa Guzmán would not appear at the signing, the actress's absence was not to be noticed given the fans' enthusiasm for seeing Ximena Herrera, Eréndira Ibarra, Lisette Morelos and **Miguel Ángel Muñoz**, who form part of the main cast of the story.

In addition, Adriana Lumina, Bianca Calderón, Andrés Montiel and Ruy Senderos were also in attendance, and they all responded to their fans for approximately two and a half hours.



Roughly three thousand persons showed up, and they did not hesitate to spend various hours of their day, lined up even under the heavy rain, to enjoy brief contact with the performers who, night after night, tell a story similar in political, social and cultural atmosphere to the current events in Mexico.

The actors appeared a little bit nervous before stepping out on stage, where they responded to the requests of those in attendance, but they insisted that although they receive different displays of support and thanks every day through Twitter, they never imagined that they would find so many people in attendance at the signing.

The story has become a real phenomenon, and the proof of this is the response that they received from the public, who shouted, threw kisses and took pictures continuously.
