Neither the rain, nor the cold, and not even the traffic around the shopping area in the direction of Patriotismo, prevented three thousand persons from camping out for hours to obtain an autograph and take a photo of the incident with the cast of the TV series *Infames* – broadcast by **Cadenatres** (Canal 28 of TV and 128 of Cablevisión and Sky) –, on Saturday afternoon.

At roughly 5:30 PM, the square was stunning, filled to its maximum capacity, the corridors of the two floors were full of hundreds of fans who could no longer find a place on the ground floor and the center of the square, where an impressive amount of people had gathered, while outside the building, the line that waited patiently to enter went all the way around the property, and even though it was raining, they stood in place for the two and a half hours that the signing lasted.

The cast, consisting of Lisette Morelos (Sol Fuentes), Eréndira Ibarra (Casilda), Ximena Herrera (Lola), **Miguel Ángel Muñoz (José María)**, Aldo Gallardo (Felipe Sánchez Trejo), Ruy Senderos

(Ricky Benavides), Bianca Calderón (Claudia Benavides), Andrés Montiel (Ferrerira) and Adriana Lumina (Valery), gathered in an office in the basement of the square to receive final instructions before going out, while outside the shouts and whistles were already deafening.

When the cast went out onto the stage, the place went crazy, the applause and appreciative cries of “*biscocho*” and “*papacito*”, sounded throughout the building.

Nevertheless, there were three names that they shouted at the top of their voices: “Casilda”, “Lola” and “**Chema**” (**Miguel Ángel Muñoz**).

“I don’t know if we have time to sign for all of you, but I'd like to thank you. In five days I’m going to Spain, but I really love you,” commented **Miguel Ángel Muñoz**, which caused the shouting to increase.

Terrifying

There were moments during the event that frightened the cast and organizers, because the euphoria of the public was so great that they started to push ahead in their enthusiasm to be with the actors and actresses; under these circumstances, the possibility of cancelling was considered for everybody’s safety; nevertheless, after a few minutes, those in attendance understood and order was reestablished.

The gifts that the stars received were everything from flowers, stuffed dolls and braziers that flew through the air, and Ruy Senderos and **Miguel Ángel Muñoz** put them on like scarves as a show of thanks to their fans.

The public sought a way to have access to the performers, and hence the building’s glass elevator was hijacked by about twenty women with cameras in their hands, and they made it go up and jammed the apparatus in order to take the best picture, creating a risk for the place’s security forces.

The most emotional moment was when the cast took a photo with a victim of the fire in San Juanico, who was handicapped by the loss of both arms.
