MIGUEL ÁNGEL MUÑOZ

Takes a risk with “*Capadocia*”

The Spanish actor will interpret one of the main characters of the third season of the series

Miguel Ángel Muñoz left his country and the opportunity to work with one of his favorite directors in order to become one of the main characters in the series “*Capadocia*”.

The Spanish actor, who enjoys great popularity in Europe for his work in series such as “*Un paso adelante*” (UPA Dance), which brought him great fame as a singer, and in movies such as “*Lope*,” accepted the offer of the producer Epigmenio Ibarra to take up residence in the Federal District (Mexico City), and bring to life Héctor, one of the starring roles of the third season.

“I really wanted to come work in Mexico, and this experience appealed to me, because I was excited about the project of this series since I found out about it.”

“Two years ago, I met Epigmenio in Spain, because we had a shared plan, but nothing was firm until he offered me ‘*Capadocia*,’ and it turned out that I already had a commitment with José Luis Garci (first Spaniard to win the Oscar, in 1983) and I said: ‘Impossible.’ But then I spoke with him and he said ‘We will do the next one’” explained the actor from Madrid, who is 28 years old.

In an interview with CIRCO, Muñoz confirmed that what attracts him most to the series (which will return to the screen of HBO in 2012) is “its commitment to what it talks about. The situation is very complicated in Mexico, and it is a series that risks making fiction of part of the reality.”

Héctor, his character, will have a direct relationship with Gabriela de la Garza and Ernesto Gómez Cruz in a special service team.

“Ernest puts together a team at the margin of the law to stop a conspiracy, and he calls on me, a Mexican who grew up in Spain, because he was a friend of my grandfather,” revealed the actor.
