Enter the dark world of the penitentiary of *Capadocia*

The Spaniard Miguel Ángel Muñoz joins the third season of the series with a leading part, his first job in Mexico.

Two years ago Miguel Ángel Muñoz was impressed by the spectacular quality of *Capadocia* in its first season, and from this moment he dreamed of participating in the cast, a wish that was granted when he joined the third season with a leading character called "Héctor" together with Ernesto Gómez Cruz and Gabriela de la Garza.

"He is one of the good guys, so to speak, a very honest man, very loyal, a person who is going to do the right thing, and he doesn't mind losing anything in his life as long as he fulfills his mission. He can even risk his life and sacrifice anything in order to do what he has to do on his path.

"He does not hesitate to examine himself or think that there is something that can be a disadvantage for him, he is going to resolve the things that he has to do and nothing else is important to him. To this end, he could leave his family, his heart, and for him this is the most important thing," explained the actor of Spanish origin.

And his character is, appropriately, a Spaniard who grew up in Mexico and who, thanks to an opportunity, begins to work as a member of a new intelligence team that will change history, and will share the plot with characters already familiar from *Capadocia*, contributing personal drama to the past and present of the story.

"All the characters have a past that is revealed in each of the episodes, and almost all of them had a difficult past, but he also has a situation of sexual tension with the character of Gabriela de la Garza, who, as usually happens with these people who dedicate their life to the service of a country, this is always separate, but he has a heart, and the person with whom he shares complicated situations on a daily basis is something more than a co-worker and in the course of these chapters this will be resolved," comments the actor.

With this opportunity, the actor, 28 years old, is glad to share his first job in Mexico with actors of the stature of Dolores Heredia, although in three weeks of shooting, he has hardly begun to interact.

"We have only spent a short time, Cecilia and Ana did not enter yet. With Dolores, I have already shared enough, with Juan Manuel Bernal too, with Marco Treviño and it is wonderful, they are all great guys, in addition to outstanding actors, whom I admire for their work. They made me feel welcome, and I am very happy," stated the young man.

In addition to the three new stories with the force of *Capadocia*, the actor has no further words to define the series, in its third season, than adjectives such as "absolutely incredible, breathtaking," since "the screenplays are spectacular, it is as if every chapter were the season finale," said the Spaniard, who even leaves the door open for a fourth edition of the series produced by Argos and HBO. ■
