The third season of *Capadocia* is presented at the MIFF

Today, March 5, the **Miami International Film Festival, MIFF**, sets the scene for the presentation of the new season of the original series from HBO Latin America, nominated in its previous seasons for three International Emmy Awards.

The presentation marks the North American debut of the third and final season of the successful series, already broadcast in Latin America, which will debut in the rest of the USA on HBO Latino in the month of September. **Miguel Ángel Muñoz** and Gabriela de la Garza (who play the characters Italia Meneses and Héctor Bolaños), will speak about their participation in this award-winning TV drama about the struggle for power and for justice in this women's prison in Mexico.



Capadocia is the name of a novel women's penitentiary in Mexico City, which originates among political interests and power struggles. This series recreates both the reality in a women's prison and the reality outside of it, showing similarities between both, sometime only to be distinguished by the bars. In the third seasons, a leading character, Héctor Bolaños, joins the series, interpreted by **Miguel Ángel**, a soldier in mind, body and soul, who acts as such. He seldom is guided by his feelings, but when his feelings assault him, his stormy and tortured natural character emerges.

Consisting of 13 episodes of 1 hour in length, the third season of *Capadocia* has HBO Latin America as its supervisor and executive producer; it is directed by Pitipol Ybarra, Carlos Carrera, Javier Patrón Fox and Moisés Ortiz Urquidi; with production by the Mexican production company, Argos. The Miami International Film Festival (MIFF), which celebrates its 30th edition from March 1-10, is considered the best festival of Iberian-American cinema in the USA. Each year the contest attracts more than 70,000 viewers, and more than 400 directors, producers, actors, actresses and professionals from the movie industry.
