“In order to construct this character I took various references and details from Josefina Vázquez Mota, Elba Esther Gordillo, such as their degree of ambition for power and their manner of addressing people,” she commented.

In *Infames*, Ibarra brings to life Casilda, a young woman in charge of media relations for the Department of the Treasury. In order to make her performance more realistic, she decided to observe women in positions of power in detail.

“I studied their careers to see how then have ascended, how they behaved. When they are hugging a child, behind their eyes you can see what they want, which is not to be with the child because they love it, but rather so that people see them doing this,” declared the actress during the debut of this production from Argos.

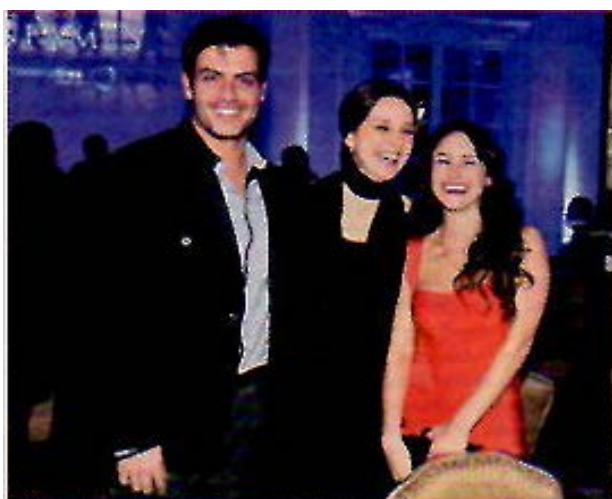

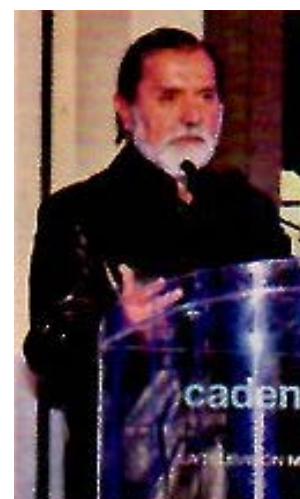
“I hope that this serves for analysis and to create greater citizen awareness,” stated the producer.
